



Linton Hall School

Admission Questions

When does Registration begin?

Completed Admission Applications can be submitted to Linton Hall School as early as October for the coming school year.

Is there a deadline for submitting Admission Applications?

In order to be eligible for the first round of Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten interviews, the application and other required documents must be received in the Linton Hall Office by January 31. After this date, new applications will be considered according to availability of space. When classes are filled, qualified applicants are placed in a waiting pool. If a space becomes available, the Admissions Committee meets to select the most suitable candidate. Families are then notified.

Do current Linton Hall families have preference?

Current students and siblings have preference in class placement until February 1.

What is involved in the Admission process?

Complete and submit the Application Form with a \$75.00 non-refundable application fee. The Application ***must include all the required documents*** (listed in the packet of information and/or listed online) when it is turned in to the office, with the exception of the Recommendation Form. The Recommendation Form must be downloaded by the applicant's family and delivered to your child's Principal and/or previous teacher. The Recommendation Form will be mailed directly to LHS. It is the responsibility of the applicant's family to have the records and documents sent/ brought to the Admissions Office. ***No interview will be scheduled until all documents have been received.***

What happens after the Application is submitted?

Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten candidates are interviewed during a designated week in February. An assessment is administered to the student on the same day as the interview.

Candidates applying for grades one through eight will be scheduled for interviews only in the grade they are applying. The Admission Application and other required paperwork will be retained on file **for the school year in which they have applied** and will be contacted if a vacancy occurs.

What are the age requirements for Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten?

Pre-Kindergarten: Must be 4 on or before September 30

Kindergarten: Must be 5 on or before September 30

Do you have to be Catholic to attend Linton Hall School?

No, we accept children from all faiths.

How are the families notified if their child is accepted/wait listed?

The Admission Committee will meet to make acceptance decisions. Letters of acceptance/wait listing will be mailed to families on **February 26**.

What happens after the acceptance letters have been received?

If your child is accepted at Linton Hall School you will receive a letter/acceptance card (letters will be mailed on February 26). The letter/card will give you a date that you must pay the deposit to secure a spot for your child for the coming year. You will also receive information answering some of your questions you might have as a new LHS parent.

During the summer you will receive a letter via email from Mrs. Poole. The letter contains important information about the coming school year. A summer tab on our website will give you information regarding summer work that we require.

It is also important that you visit the Linton Hall website www.lintonhall.edu. We communicate updates via our website.

Are Applications and Waiting Lists carried over from one year to the next?

No, Applications and Waiting Lists are **NOT** carried over from one year to the next.
